The research group of Molecular Entomology under the European Program HORIZON-CL6-2022-FARM2FORK-01, entitled "Risk Assessment InnOvation for low-risk pesticides, RATION" (Program Coordinator Prof. John Vontas) invites applications for one (1) motivated Postdoctoral Researcher

#### About the lab

Molecular Entomology Lab in IMBB-FORTH has a main interest to study and understand the mechanisms by which disease vectors and agricultural pests develop resistance to insecticides, as well as explore novel insecticide targets and biotechnology-based approaches to control insects.

## About the project:

Low risk pesticides (LRP) are gaining ground in the global market, as substitutes of synthetic pesticides. Despite ongoing regulatory efforts by the European Commission, we are still lacking a concrete risk assessment (RA) scheme relevant to LRPs, a point which blocks LRPs reaching the EU market. RATION timely comes to address these regulatory constraints and aims to develop a novel RA scheme, supported by the necessary guidance on methods and tools, tailored to the specific characteristics of established and emerging LRP solutions.

### **Evaluation procedure**

Applications will be evaluated by a three-member evaluation committee. In case of interview procedure, applicants will be invited to participate in person or teleconference.
